# 20<sup>th</sup> Summer School of Myology

## First announcement

**Venue:** Institut de Myologie, Bâtiment Babinski, La Salpêtrière Hospital, 50-52, Bd Vincent Auriol, Paris 13.

**Date:** Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> June (9.30 a.m.) - Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> June (4.30 pm), 2017.

**Profile required:** physicians or scientists expressing some interest in myology in general and in neuromuscular disorders in particular. Preferably juniors. Physiotherapists and other paramedics involved in management and clinical research are also welcome.

**Number of participants:** 60 max.

**Topics:** basic myology - muscular dystrophies - spinal muscular atrophies and hereditary neuropathies - congenital muscular dystrophies - congenital myopathies - metabolic myopathies – myasthenic syndromes - chanellopathies - cardiomyopathies – genetic counselling - management and novel therapies.

**Format:** intensive 7-day course (8.30 am – 5.30 pm).

- *Morning session* : 4 lectures including fundamental and practical aspects in one given area of myology.
- *Early-afternoon session* : Interactive workshops : case studies, muscle imaging, myogenetics...
- *Late-afternoon session* : plenary lecture on a more general topic by a guest speaker.

**Certificate and Credits:** a certificate of attendance will be delivered on the last day as well as 7 CME points.

**Teachers:** Faculties from France (mainly from the Institut de Myologie of Paris) and from abroad. All are internationally recognised experts.

**Scientific committee:** J. Andoni Urtizbera, Norma B. Romero, Gisèle Bonne, Pascale Richard, Bruno Eymard, Olivier Benveniste, Edoardo Malfatti, Helge Amthor, Hanns Lochmüller.

**Official language:** English.

**Registration fee:** Euros 500. Cover all teaching materials (including the electronic version of the lectures with the exception of clinical cases studied during the interactive workshops), coffee breaks and midday luncheons. A minimal extra-fee may be requested for the (optional) Gala Dinner. Payment of fees via bank transfer preferably.
